Tashkent Chemical and Technological Institute, Uzbekistan (<http://tkti.uz>) - A leading chemical and technological university in the Republic of Uzbekistan and Central Asia, specializing in the training of qualified specialists in the field of chemistry and chemical technology, food technology, food safety, technology of oils, essential oils, perfume and cosmetic products, oil and gas processing, ecology, biotechnology, oenology, pulp technology, woodworking, technological machinery and equipment, metrology, management and marketing, etc.

Tashkent Institute of Chemical Technology, founded by the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on May 6, 1991, by combining several faculties of the former Tashkent Polytechnic Institute, which has been operating since 1929, was created in order to improve the level of higher technical education in the republic, and provides training of engineering and scientific personnel for the branches of the national economy of the Republic of Uzbekistan. During its activity, the Institute has trained more than 10 thousand highly qualified process engineers for the chemical, oil and gas, food, construction and other sectors of the country's economy.

THTI is accredited to provide four-year bachelor's degree programs, two-year Master's degree programs, and doctoral degree programs (PhD and DSc). The Institute trains specialists in 29 bachelor's degree programs, 30 master's degree programs, 16 doctoral programs, 5 bachelor's degree programs for issuing a double diploma; 7 master's degree programs for double diplomas, 1 doctoral program for a double diploma ("Kotyutel Program"). Today, the Institute has 7800 full-time and part-time undergraduate students, 445 undergraduates, and 139 doctoral students.

Training seminars and lectures are regularly organized with invited foreign professors and teachers from universities in Europe, the USA, Japan, China, Russia, Korea, Mexico, Kazakhstan, Belarus, etc. In addition, the Tashkent Institute of Chemical Technology has two specialized scientific councils for awarding scientific degrees, the Uzbek-Chinese Joint Research Laboratory for the Modernization of Asphalt Concrete Technology, the Laboratory of Nanotechnology and Nanomaterials, and the Laboratory of Modern Physical and Chemical Analysis.
