Brief summary of the subject: "UZBEK LANGUAGE" is a course included in the block of general				
professional subjects, and it is advisable to teach it in the 1st year. This science belongs to the category				
of humanities. Thorough mastery of the subject, along with knowledge of theoretical and practical				
materials, serves as a skill during students' pedagogical and industrial practice and in postgraduate work.				

Objective of the discipline: development and improvement of the skills of speech activity acquired by students at the lower levels of education, achieving thorough knowledge of the state language within the chosen specialty, developing the communicative competence of academic and technical communication in the Uzbek language in future specialists, that is, the ability to correctly use language tools in certain speech situations in scientific and practical activities, in particular, to achieve oral and written speech literacy in the Uzbek language by analyzing the received information, obtaining new information from texts, creating texts related to the field, preparing presentations on professional topics.

Students are taught to develop linguistic competencies aimed at developing oral and written literacy in the Uzbek language, expressing their attitude to thoughts, compiling specialized texts in various speech styles, reading comprehensively and translating, improving the skills of freely compiling various types of texts, understanding and processing information in the Uzbek language, expressing a critical, analytical attitude towards it, and writing official documents.

At the end of the course, students will acquire the following skills and abilities:

- Can effectively use oral and written speech in scientific and professional fields, knows and can use professional terminology, features of oral and written speech;
- creates specialized texts in the Uzbek language, analyzes and edits information, prepares and formalizes industry documents, increases speech competence;

• Correctly perceives the text in the specialty, highlights the most important information based on their knowledge, forms and can justify their point of view:

Practical exercises

Practical classes will be conducted separately for each academic group in an auditorium equipped with multimedia devices. Classes are conducted using active and interactive methods, using the "Case Study" technology. Visual materials and information are transmitted using multimedia devices. All lessons are structured according to a scheme: vocabulary work, grammatical comments, relevant thematic texts, and learning exercises.

A lot of space has been allocated for reinforcing the educational material. These are tests, questions, exercises, and other tasks that help students acquire skills in the subject. They contribute to the formation of amateur activity and reproductive activity of undergraduate students.
